

Moss Street Paint In Job Descriptions

Info Table Attendants: provide information regarding all aspects of the MSPI and the Gallery to the public, distribute water and collect donations and completed ballots for draws.

Public Greeters: Welcome and invite donations from the visitors and provide information to the public including the MSPI Artist Map.

Team Leaders: The Team Leader is the on-site coordinator for their “street section”, ensuring that volunteer requirements and the volunteers’ needs are being met. The Team Leader also acts as the primary liaison with the Volunteer Coordinator – interview with Volunteer Coordinator is required.

Assistant Leaders: These volunteers will assist the Team Leaders and will offer assistance to all members of their team including Info Table, Greeters and Traffic Wardens. They will also travel between the other teams and shuffle supplies and information.

Traffic Marshalls: Positioned at specific intersections, these volunteers are an important point of contact for the public. They will hand out MSPI Artist Maps and provide information about road closures and MSPI event to the public.

- Volunteers will be placed into one of 8 teams that will cover a specific area along Moss Street between 11am – 5pm.
- All shifts are a minimum of three hours
- Event information will be distributed at the informal training session on Saturday, July 11th or Thursday July 16th.
